## **Specific Explanations for Advanced Novice Singles and Pairs**

- Level Explanations:** For Advanced Novice Singles and Pairs, in all elements which are subject to Levels, Level Features up to Level 4 are counted
- Fall Explanations:** For Advanced Novice Singles and Pairs, the deduction for a fall is 0.5.
- There will be no deduction for a fall after a fully rotated 2 A or triple jump.

In the season 2010/2011 the composition of the Short Dance will contain 5 Required Elements in total:  
2 Required Elements in the Pattern Dance Part:  
1 sequence of the Golden Waltz is divided into 2 sections and each of these sections is considered as one of the two Required Elements.  
3 Required Elements in the Creative Dance Part (Short Lift, Midline Not Touching Step Sequence and Set of sequential Twizzles.
- The music of the entire Short Dance (including music for specified Pattern Dance) is provided by the couple and may be vocal.
- The music for the specified Pattern dance must be within the announced tempo range (61-63 measures of 3 beats per minute).
- The choreography of the Creative Dance Part may be to the same rhythm as the Specific Pattern Dance (Waltz) or to one or two of the rhythms chosen from the following rhythms: Foxtrot, Quickstep, Tango, which can be included in any order.
- Free Dance:** Duration: 4 min +/- 10 sec

**Well Balanced Program and Required Elements:**

In the season 2010/2011 the composition of the Short Dance will contain 5 Required Elements in total:

2 Required Elements in the Pattern Dance Part:  
2 sequences of the Viennese Waltz performed one after the other, will be considered as 2 Required Elements

3 Required Elements in the Creative Part (Short Lift, Midline Not Touching Step Sequence and Set of Sequential Twizzles)

The music of entire Short Dance (including music for specified Pattern dance) is provided by the couple and may be vocal.

The music of the specified Pattern Dance Viennese Waltz must be within the announced tempo range (51-53 measures of 3 beats per minute).

The Viennese Waltz may be skated anywhere in the Short Dance, but it must be started with Step #1 and skated towards the judges (Step#1 of the Dance must be skated on the left side from the judges position).

Two full sequences of the dance must be performed one after the other.

The choreography of the Creative Part may be to the same rhythm as the specified Pattern Dance (Waltz) or to one or two of the rhythms chosen from the following rhythms: Foxtrot, Quickstep, Tango, which can be included in any order.

**Free Dance:**

Duration: 3 ½ min +/- 10 sec

In accordance with ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Ice Dance 2010 Rule 610 and all pertinent ISU Communications.



**Well Balanced Program and Required Elements:**  
ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2010, Rule 610.2 and the relevant ISU Communication must be observed.

## **Music**

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on CD, MD or DAT format. In accordance with Rule 343 all cassettes and discs must show the Competition event, the Competitors name, the Members name and the exact running time of the Music (not skating time) including any starting signal, and must be submitted at the time of registration.

## **Planned Program Sheet**

Attached "Planned Program Sheets" have to be filled in precisely and must return together with the entry forms to the Organizing Committee in time.

## **Accreditation**

The official accreditation is at the main entrance of the Ice Rink.  
Accreditation will be given to all Competitors, Judges and Coaches.

## **Results**

The determination and publication of the results will be done according to ISU Technical Rules for Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2010, Rule 352 and 353.

## **Awards**

The first three best placed competitors and couples in each event will be awarded by Medals or Trophies, there will be Diplomas for all participants. The Award Ceremonies will be published with the official Time - Schedule.

## **Liability**

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the Bavarian Open Figure Skating and Ice Dance 2011, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.
